Day 1: 28 Aug 2025 / 6 Sept 2025: Arrival Sandakan/ Sepilok	
<p><b>Suggested Flight:</b>  <a href="#">AK6496 ETD1125hrs ETA1210hrs BKL - SDK (Post)</a></p> <p>Arrive Sandakan Airport, meet, greet, and proceed, transfer to My Nature Resort for lunch then check into your room.</p> <p><b>Remarks:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>For post-tour arrangement:</b> Breakfast at leisure. 0925hrs Check out and meet at hotel lobby for transfer to Kota Kinabalu Airport 2hrs prior to your flight departure to Sandakan.</li> <li>MY Nature Resort - A 1,500-foot-long, up-and-down structure has been built for you to explore before dark. The guided night walk will be led by the in-house guide as an optional tour before or after dinner, depending on the weather. 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1600hrs Pick up from resort and we proceed to visit Rainforest Discovery Centre. Take a bird view of the centre from the canopy walk and hanging bridge, explore the botanical garden, home to various species of flora. Thereafter return to resort.

18:00hrs, be ready at "The Flying Squirrel" platform to witness these amazing creatures in action.

After dinner, Guided Night Walk at our nature board walk going up and down structure next to the Sepilok Protected Forest Reserve.

## Day 2: 29 Aug 2025 / 7 Sept 2025: Sepilok / Abai

Breakfast at leisure.



0900hrs transfer to Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre. Head to the Centre's Outdoor Nursery Viewing Gallery to try and catch a glimpse of these young orphans who may be at their training grounds. Learn about the challenges faced by the Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre, which was established in 1964 to rehabilitate orphaned baby orangutans and release them into the wild.

Proceed to the free roaming area feeding platform. 1000hrs witness feeding of Orangutan. At this center, observe man's closest relative "the Orangutan" being rehabilitated to become wild in their natural habitat and experience a walk in Tropical Lowland Dipterocarp Forest of Borneo.

### **Note on Camera Use at Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre:**

*For any camera with zoom lens from 100 to 400mm, video camera or other video recording equipment for personal use are chargeable at RM10.00 per unit. For any camera (fixed-lens – 400mm and above) or any film-making equipment are chargeable at RM1,000.00 per unit. Mode of payment is cash only.*

1030hrs proceed to visit the Borneo Sun Bear Conservation Centre offers the chance to see rescued sun bears on their road to rehabilitation as well as local flora and fauna such as orangutans, macaques, squirrels, and diverse tropical tree species. The Conservation Centre is currently home to 43 rescued bears and 1 captive born, each with their own unique personality. Sun bears in the wild face many threats. All bears at the centre are orphaned and/or ex-captive bears, often found in unnatural conditions, with inadequate diets and no stimulation. Thereafter, return to resort for lunch.



1115hrs depart resort and transfer to jetty in Sandakan for scheduled boat departs at 1200noon. Take an hour boat cruise up to the Lower Kinabatangan River Sanctuary where you will take your lunch at Abai Jungle Restaurant. This is a wonderful journey of discovery which starts from the waters of Sulu Sea of Sandakan Town through a magnificent scenery of the Mangrove Forest. Check in at Abai Jungle Lodge.

Late in the afternoon, you will be experiencing a cruise to search for wildlife until the sunsets while enjoying a cup of coffee and by the night falls continue the night cruise to witness the fireflies as Christmas tree. Return to the

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lodge for dinner. After dinner, again experience the "Jungle at night" at our nature boardwalk to search for birds, snakes, insects, and other wildlife with our nature guide.

## Day 3: 30 Aug 2025 / 8 Sept 2025: Abai / Sukau

Wake up by the calls of nature. Early morning takes a river trip to Pitas Oxbow Lake to observe wildlife and experience the unique of Pitas Oxbow Lake. Check out after breakfast, at 1000hrs proceed by boat transfer to Sukau. Lunch and check in at Kinabatangan Riverside Lodge

Late afternoon, take another river cruise to Menanggul River, a small tributary of the Kinabatangan. Return to lodge for dinner and rest of the evening at own leisure.

**Day 1: 28 Aug 2025 / 6 Sept 2025: Arrival Kuching / Sarawak Sunset Cruise**

#### Suggested Flight:

MH2530 ETD1230hrs ETA1420hrs KUL – KCH (Pre)

FY2562 ETD1230hrs ETA1355hrs BKI – KCH (Post)

Meet and greet at Kuching International Airport and then proceed directly transfer to Hilton Hotel for check in and rest.

1645hrs Pickup from the hotel and proceed to the Waterfront for the 1.5-hours river cruise.

1700hrs the very best way to see and enjoy historic Kuching is from the Sarawak River, the main artery around which the city has grown. The river cruise gives you a view of the city and its surroundings that is impossible to experience from dry land. You will enjoy unobstructed views of every aspect of traditional life on the river. This cruise takes you past a host of fascinating sights to get a close-up view of traditional life on and around the river. The boat glides past colourful Malay Villages, the elegant City Mosque, the Astana, Fort Margherita and the Kuching Waterfront. Along the way you will see brightly painted tambangs ferrying passengers, villagers going about their everyday activities, and fishing boats and wooden cargo vessels plying the river. With the added pleasure of the



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setting sun as a backdrop (weather permitting). The cruise ends with colourful lights coming on all along the Kuching Waterfront as you approach the jetty. Light Refreshment serves onboard.

1830hrs the cruise ends with a shuttle ride to Telang Usan Restaurant for dinner before returning to the hotel.

**Day 2: 29 Aug 2025 / 7 Sept 2025: Kuching A Blast in The Past / Kuching Unique Gastronomic Adventure Cuisine**

Breakfast at hotel. 0730hrs pick up from hotel then proceed transfer to Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight departure to Kuching, Sarawak

Arrive Kuching International Airport, meet, greet and proceed lunch at a local restaurant. Thereafter, continue tour with a trail to the past. This walkabout tour commences at the Kuching waterfront, with a visit to the "Tua Tek Kong" Chinese temple and Chinese Historical Museum where the historical Fort Margherita can be viewed on the other side of the Sarawak River. From the temple you will walk through Carpenter Street, consisting of old shop houses on both sides of the narrow street passage. At the end of the street junction, you pass by the General Post Office. Also situated around this area are historical buildings and monuments built during the era of the Brooke dynasty which consists of the Round Tower, the Pavillion, the Brooke Memorial Monument, the Square Tower and the Old Court House. Proceed to India Street, a pedestrians' shopping mall specializing in local and imported textiles. From India Street, walk through a narrow-covered passageway where you will find a Masjid India on your left with very low walls built sometime in the mid-19th century. Just as you reach the end of the passageway, your senses will detect the slight aroma of Indian spices which navigates you to Gambier Street. Proceed to Brooke Dockyard and Dockyard Lane passing by the Old Fire Brigade Station (known now as the open-air market). Our last stop is a direct walk pass the Merdeka Square to the St Thomas's Cathedral for a short visit.

Return to hotel after the tour.

1500 hours, meet your guide at the hotel lobby, before we start the gastronomical tour. The food trip tour highlights some local dishes and what locals in Kuching enjoy during the morning, in the afternoon or at night. Depart from your hotel and start your street food adventure to Lau Ya Keng at Carpenter Street for Sarawak Laksa with ice cold drinks. Across the food court, a humble hawker stall sells the traditional Lek Tau Suang, a porridge like dessert which good to reduce body heat. Walking down the lane towards Black Bean Coffee. This small café offers an aromatic Sarawak Gourmet Coffee, blended from fresh coffee beans.

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Your journey continues towards the Waterfront where you will catch a sampan or known as Penambang to cross the Sarawak River. This northern part of the city is inhabited by mostly Malay kampongs and unique to their identity, the famous Sarawak Layer Cake or Kek Lapis can be easily found here, fresh out of the oven.

Continue the food adventure to a local coffee shop has multiple stalls operating and each offers its own specialty such as local delights like, Sarawak Laksa, Mee Kolo, Tomato Mee, Kopi O and mixed coconut & sugarcane drink.

Return to the city centre and the final stop for a sweet dessert, the Gula Apong Ice Cream. Enjoy the fresh cold ice cream with palm sugar which will wrap the whole food journey.

## Day 3: 30 Aug 2025 / 8 Sept 2025: Semenggoh /Mongkos Bidayuh Longhouse

Breakfast at hotel.

0800hrs Pickup from the hotel and drive for 40 minutes to Semenggoh Nature Reserve.

0840hrs Upon arrival, head to the feeding area for a ranger briefing. 0900hrs the feeding session begins and lasts one hour. Note that seeing an orangutan is not certain because they are semi-wild.

1000hrs After the feeding period, depart Kuching on a 2-hour drive for a day visit to Mongkos Longhouse. Upon reaching Serian, the nearest town there, we visit its farmer's market. 1200hrs continue journey and upon arrival, proceed with a tour of the longhouse. Learn about the old history of the village. Walk around and enjoy its surroundings and daily routine. Afterwards, enjoy a locally prepared lunch at the village's homestay café. After lunch, we depart for Kuching. 1500hrs Depart from Mongkos and transfer back to Kuching.

1730hrs: Arrive at hotel and rest before transfer to a local restaurant for dinner at 1930hrs. Return to hotel after the dinner and rest of the evening at own leisure.

#### Day 1: 6 Sept 2025: Kota Kinabalu / Kinabalu Park



1130 hour. Take a scenic 2 hours' drive to Kinabalu Park, passing by villages and paddy fields along mountainous roads that wind along the Crocker range. Arrive Kinabalu Park which home to a wide range unspoilt flora and fauna. Check in and dinner. Overnight stay at Kinabalu Park

Note : There are many trails in the park, if you wish to do more jungle walk, please get advice from the park ranger

**Overnight** : Kinabalu National Park (Sutera Sanctuary Lodge) - ROH

#### Day 2: 7 Sept 2025: Kinabalu Park HQ / Laban Rata

##### Park HQ / Timphon Gate / Mount Kinabalu / Laban Rata

Breakfast at Park Restaurant. Thereafter, collect your packed lunch. Proceed to the Park HQ to register for the climb, meet your assigned mountain guide and apply for your ID TAG. Remember to wear your ID TAG at all times. You'll then be transferred to starting point – Timpohon Gate—where your journey and quest to the summit of Borneo's highest mountain begins! The climb will take approximately 4-5hours. The trek will pass by different vegetation zones from Oak and Chestnut to mossy and eventually to alpine type of vegetation. Arrive and check in to one of the assorted Laban Rata huts at 3272m (non-heated dormitory bed) in the late afternoon. Buffet dinner at Laban Rata restaurant and overnight

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## Day 3: 8 Sept 2025: Low Peak / Kota Kinabalu

### Low's Peak / Descend Mount Kinabalu / Kota Kinabalu (Supper/Breakfast/Lunch)

0200 hours. Wake up for early supper and depart for continuation of journey towards the summit of Mount Kinabalu. The journey up to the Low's peak at 4,095m will test your fitness and determination. Depending on speed of trekking, you might be able to experience the glorious sunrise over the majestic Mt. Kinabalu if weather permits. 0700 hours Descend back to Laban Rata for late breakfast and check out. Trek down to Timpohon Gate for transfer back to the Kinabalu Park Headquarters. Congratulations, you can now collect your Certificate of Achievement! Buffet lunch will be served at the Balsam restaurant in Kinabalu Park. Transfer back to Kota Kinabalu city. Journey takes approximately 2 hours.
