# 1. INTRODUCTION TO SERI MENGASIH CENTRE

- Seri Mengasih Centre is a Non-Government Organisation (NGO) known as the Registered Trustees of Seri Mengasih Trust.
- Relying mainly on school fees, public donations and fundraising projects for its operation costs.
- Established as the first special education school in Sabah in January 1981 (44 years now)

## **ESTABLISHMENT**

- Special developmental training centre, dedicated to providing a safe, inclusive, and nurturing environment for special needs children.
- It is designed to support individuals from 3 years old up to 19 years old
- Offers a range of training programme and services tailored to their unique needs including Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Down Syndrome, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Slow Learner, etc.

# **OUR PROGRAMME – KOLOLO METHOD (JAPAN)**

- The Kololo Method is an educational training programme which was developed in Japan for persons with Autism that is based on its theory of brain development, and the theory of changing behaviour.
- Seri Mengasih Centre has been in operation since 1981 (44 years) and has been using the Kololo Method for more than 20 years.
- SMC is the only Autism Centre in Malaysia that has authorized to use the method originated from Japan.



- The Kololo Method is a general term for the educational training programme (Autism Spectrum Disorder)
- Developed in Japan by Mr Ishii Hijiri, together with Ms Saeko Kubota in 1980 for persons with Autism.
- Parents are the main trainers with teachers as facilitators. (Compulsory training)

Seri Mengasih Centre is the first special education centre in Malaysia to adopt and implement the Kololo Method since 1999.

Enrolment age: 1. ASD Junior (3-10 years)

2. ASD Senior (11-19 years old)



# **ASD KOLOLO METHOD**

### **Kololo Method**

- 1. Behaviour Training To raise awareness level, attention, focus, stop repetitive action, set good pace behaviour
- a) Group Walking (1 hour 2 hours)
- b) Dynamic Rhythm + Hand Games Group exercise that follows tempo of the music.
- c) Circuit Training
- 2. Self Care Toilet Training, Functional Living Skills
- 3. Feeding Training Proper Eating Manners, Proper Rhythm of Chewing & Swallowing, Balance Diet
- 4. Basic Academics Matching, copying letters, picture & letters matching, writing as watching picture card, speaking as watching picture/word cards


